CONSULTATIONS

EFI provides minority and small businesses with one-on-one consultations designed to educate business owners concerning programs focused on training, development and financing options.

EFI assists minority and small businesses in obtaining loan approvals by providing lender with necessary security, in the form of 504 bridge loans, partial loan participations or loan guarantees.

STEP 2: Lender (not business owner) applies for loan guarantee or participation through EFI.
